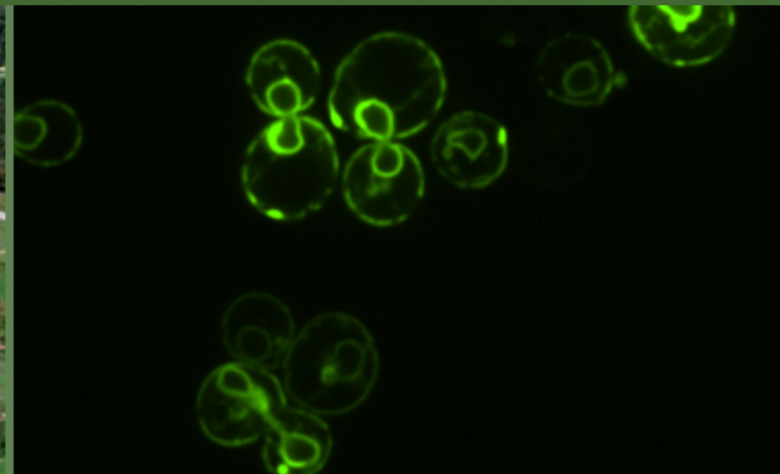
ABOUT
