- To provide students with opportunities to evaluate the particular strengths and limitations of the different model organisms introduced on the course.

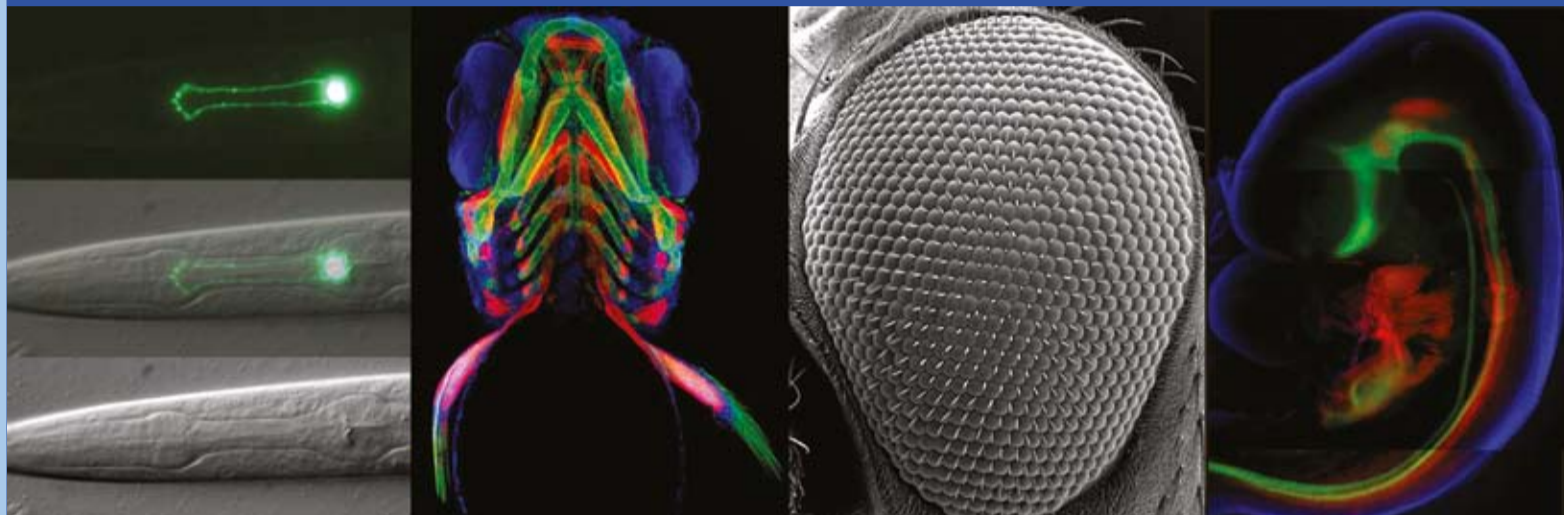
